1. Homework Sessions are graded on a point system (not new, just clarifying)
2. Each problem is one point (abc...z parts are counted as one point each)
3. Exceptions to the above points are any and all online assignments which are discussed later
4. Homework Sessions will include the following but are not limited to: textbook assignments, worksheets, myap quizzes, desmos activities, online assignments, etc.
5. Each individual assignment in the homework session is due the next school day after it is assigned (unless otherwise scheduled by me)
6. Because I share solutions on the due date, late work is not accepted unless you were absent
7. If we are online for a time of quarantine as mandated by the school, due dates still apply because I will give solutions via zoom or some other method
8. Problems are complete if they show the following: the problem copied (if not given on a worksheet that you have space to work on), an attempt at the steps required to get a correct answer, and an attempt at using proper notation
9. Points are not earned if there is no work as described above (exception: when there is no work to show, such as reading a limit from a graph, etc.)
10. Completed problems are "counted" on the day they are due by a class member and that number is clearly marked in ink at the top of the assignment with the "counter's" initials
11. If we are online for a time of quarantine as mandated by the school, you will upload a clear picture* of all of the problems you completed in the assignment to google classroom and I will count and keep track of what you have done
12. I will keep count of all online assignments (i.e. myap, desmos, etc.) and will add the points earned to your total points completed when you turn in the Homework Session
13. Online assignments (myap, desmos, etc.) will count at least 20 points in the total point count (understand you may earn less than 20 points if you did not complete the entire online assignment on an assignment worth 20 points)
14. Quizzes assigned from myap.collegeboard.org will count a minimum of 20 points (per quiz) towards the total point count
15. Myap quizzes are done online through myap.collegeboard.org and are scheduled—you must complete the quiz within the scheduled time to earn the points
16. Myap quizzes are announced on the class blog-check daily
17. Myap quizzes are short and should be able to be completed within 10-20 minutes or less
18. The entire Homework Session is due on test day-put in date order and stapled together
19. If we are online for a time of quarantine as mandated by the school, the Homework Session hard copies will still be turned in on the day we take the corresponding test when we return to in person -- in date order and stapled
20. Items included in the Homework Session that you will not have a hard copy to turn in but are still in the total point count are: myap quizzes, desmos activities, online assignments, etc.
21. This is how I will figure your final Homework Session grade: divide how many problems you completed by how many were assigned then multiply by 100
*If you have an iphone, use the note app to take a picture (scan document). Iphone will save the picture as a pdf. Send it to me from your phone: cookp@woisd.net. I don't know if android has a similar feature/app.
*You may need to place your work under a light source, and/or take a picture showing half a page at a time, that helps with clarity. Sometimes when you try to fit the whole page into one picture, it is too blurry on my end to see anything.
